Report from the Graduate Admissions committee – Ken Lohmann

- 26 MCDB students offered admission: 12 accepted, 7 declined, 7 undecided
- 14 EEOB students offered admission: 4 accepted, 5 declined, 5 undecided
- 2 MCDB/EEOB crossover students offered admission: 0 accepted, 1 declined, 1 undecided
- discussion about improving EEOB admissions: stipend the main issue, improvement to dept. website to highlight EEOB faculty clusters suggested

Update on the Commencement Recognition Ceremony – Bill Kier
